



An Introduction

A Beginning that Breathed Hope in Many Lives.



It was in the late 90s that our visionary, the then Metropolitan Mar Kuriakose Kunnasserry, Archeparchy of Kottayam Diocese, felt the need for a specialized cancer treatment centre in Central Kerala. With limited treatment facilities in the Government Hospitals in Kerala at that time, cancer patients had to wait for many months to get a proper treatment. This often led to worsening and progression of their condition, leading to an incurable status. While the rich could travel to different places to seek expert care, the poor and mediocre people were helpless. An affordable and reliable cancer centre for all became the then need of the hour. Hence, he envisioned a full-fledged Cancer Centre and took steps to build it in the Caritas Hospital Campus. It began functioning in January 2000, initially with Surgical Oncology department alone.





Under the direct supervision of Metropolitan Mar Kuriakose
Kunnasserry, the then Director Rev. Fr. Simon Pazhukayil and
Rev. Fr. Jacob Kollaparampil, a new and wider project - Caritas Cancer
Institute was designed. Foundation stone for the new project was
laid on 24th February 2002 and fund was made available through
the generous contribution of the Laity of Kottayam Archdiocese,
the Italian Bishops Conference and various congregations of the
Kottayam Archdiocese. Caritas Cancer Institute was inaugurated by
Metropolitan Mar Kuriakose Kunnasserry on 24th February 2003.





Caritas Cancer Institute became the first-of-its-kind centre, exclusively for Cancer care in Central Kerala. Soon, in addition to Surgical Oncology, Medical Oncology, Radiation Oncology, Oncopathology and Palliative Care divisions were started. Later, Community Oncology and Psycho-Oncology divisions were also added.

The institute started with a strength of 40 beds with a 20-bedded Day Care Chemo suite, Surgical Oncology theatre and ICU, which were later expanded and modernized. Initially, Caritas Cancer Institute was equipped with Siemens Primus Linear Accelerator and Selectron HDR for Brachytherapy, which offered the best radiation therapy technologies available in Kerala at that time. Five years down the lane, the Radiation Oncology department was expanded with the addition of the second advanced Linear Accelerator - Siemens Primus Plus. In November 2015, Varian Unique Performance Linear Accelerator was inaugurated by Archbishop Mar Mathew Moolakkatt. Caritas Cancer Institute is soon expecting the addition of a new Linear Accelerator - Varian TrueBeam incorporating all the latest technologies. Home Care facility was started in 2006, which served as a big boon for the palliative patients. The following years witnessed many advances in Caritas Cancer Institute with the advent of Advanced Blood Separation and Apheresis Therapy, Bone Marrow Transplant Unit and Transplant ICU. The Nuclear Medicine Department was started in 2018 with PET-CT scan and Radioiodine Therapy, presently offering many latest diagnostic and therapeutic interventions. In the academic area, Caritas Cancer Institute offers the DNB and DrNB courses in both Radiation and Medical Oncology.

Multidisciplinary Tumor Board, including all the concerned specialists, is regularly conducted to discuss the management and care of cancer patients whenever required. This, in turn, assures optimum treatment plan for our patients.

Surgical Oncology, the first Cancer specific department, which was started in Caritas Hospital 22 years ago, undertakes surgical management of a wide range of cancers thereby delivering personalized treatment with utmost care. Over 24000 patients attended the department and more than 16000 Cancer Surgeries (both Minor and Major) have been carried out till date. The Surgical Oncology department handles all types of Open and Minimal Access Surgeries. The department has dedicated Operation Theatres, Postoperative Care ICUs, Wards, and Rooms.

The dedicated Medical Oncology department at Caritas Cancer Institute is one of the oldest in Kerala devoted to systematic and evidence-based practices to treat cancer in both children and adults. It is equipped to handle all types of Oncological emergencies supported by a specialized team of highly experienced doctors, trained nurses and support staff. The Day Care Chemo area was initially started with 20 beds and was recently upgraded to 35 beds, including three dedicated Chemotherapy suites. It is also the first centre in Central Kerala to start Autologous Stem Cell Transplantation.

The Nuclear Medicine department at Caritas Cancer Institute boasts a well-aligned and experienced team, best-in-class infrastructure and unique Molecular Imaging facility to ensure ideal treatment solutions at par with the international standards. The PET-CT and Gamma Camera Imaging (Planar, SPECT and SPECT-CT) services provided at the department helps to provide personalised medical care by giving a precise understanding of the molecular processes at the cellular level to significantly improve diagnosis and treatment outcomes. We have both diagnostic and therapeutic services .The department is equipped with high-dose isolation ward facility to treat patients on radionuclide therapy. This facility is available only in a very few hospitals across Kerala.

Initiated in 2004, the Pain & Palliative Care department at Caritas Cancer Institute practices a multidisciplinary approach and undertakes the total care of mainly those cancer patients who no longer respond to curative treatments and therapies. The services offered at the department help the patients and their families to cope with the condition and improve their quality of life through controlling symptoms, relieving pain and suffering. It responds to the physical, mental, psychosocial, economic and spiritual needs and extends necessary support in bereavement. The care at the department has also widened to serve patients suffering from other chronic and incurable diseases like chronic rheumatoid arthritis, COPD, Stroke, Paraplegia, Spine Injury, Old Age, etc. The multidisciplinary team of doctors, nurses and trained volunteers is the strong pillar of support for patients seeking palliative care.
