The expert multidisciplinary team at the Centre of Excellence in Critical Care Medicine is equipped to handle different emergencies, multi-organ failure, Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome (ARDS), Sepsis, Septic Shock, serious morbid conditions and other medical complications. The department has a specialised trauma care section. A fully equipped team would be ready when the need arises to ensure protection for patients fighting infections, especially when the threat of spreading viruses and bacteria is high.
